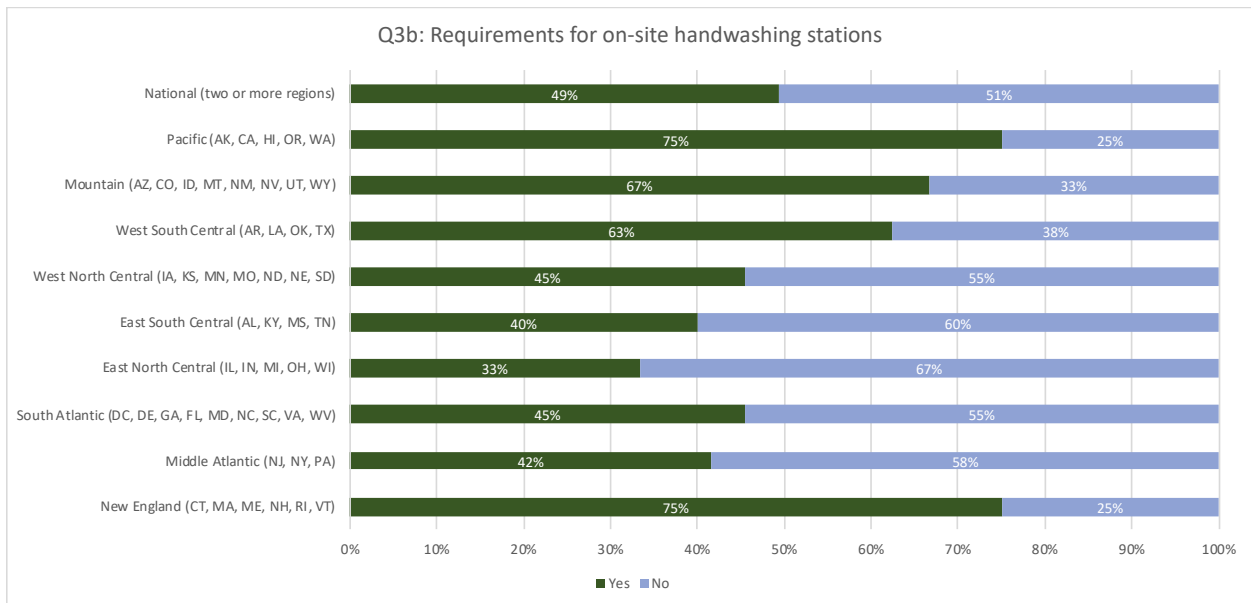

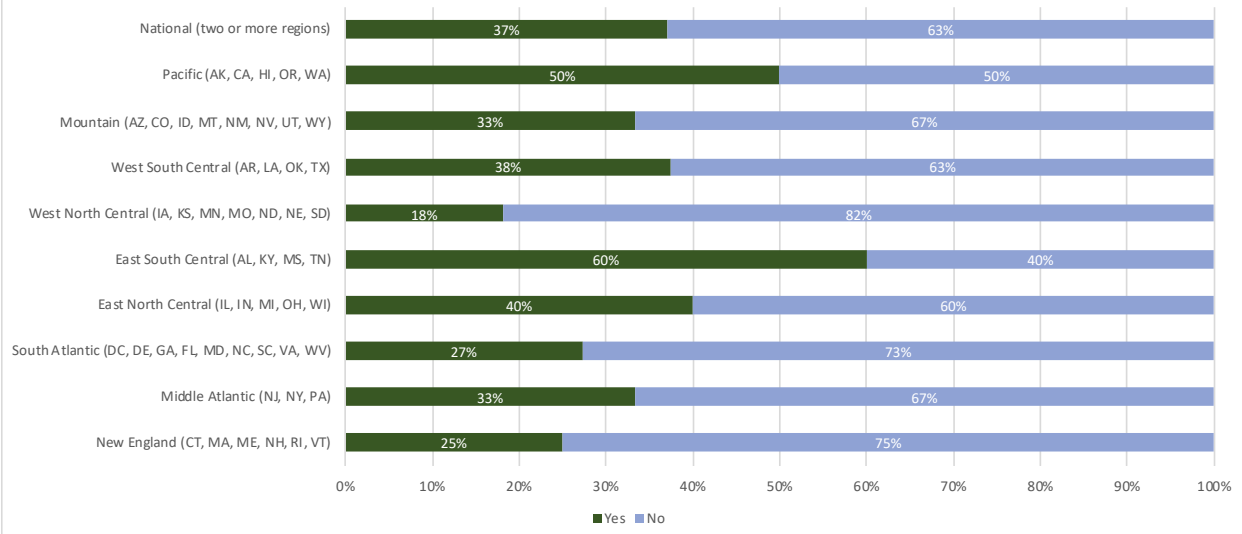
Q2: For contractors performing industrial work, please select the amount of time that represents your project backlog as of January 1, 2021.



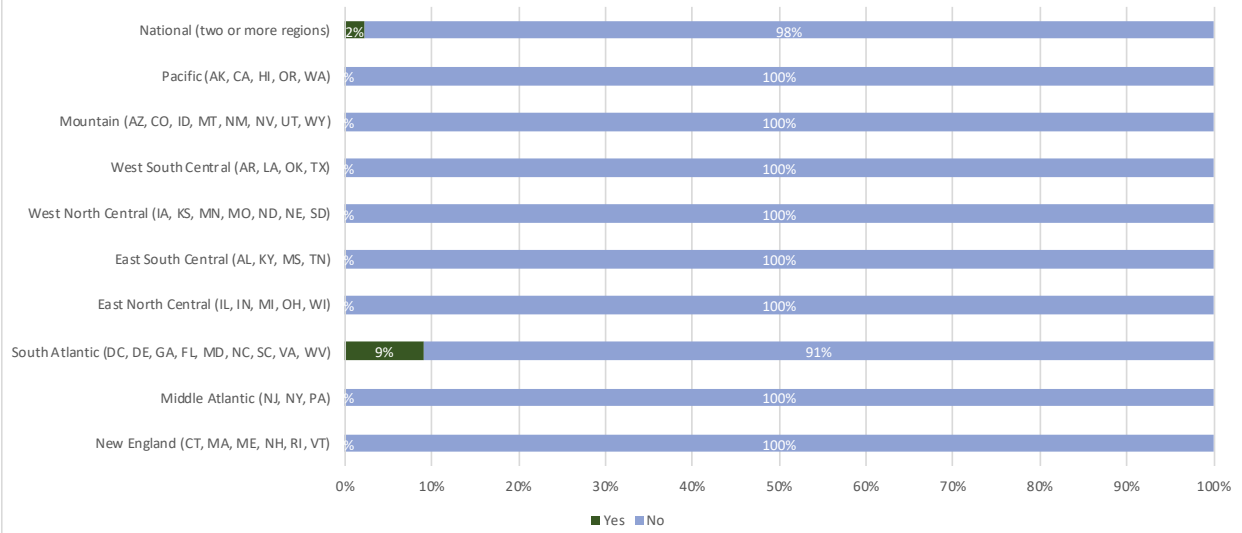
**Q3: Has your state or local jurisdiction imposed Covid related workplace safety measures that currently impact your operations? (Select all that apply)**



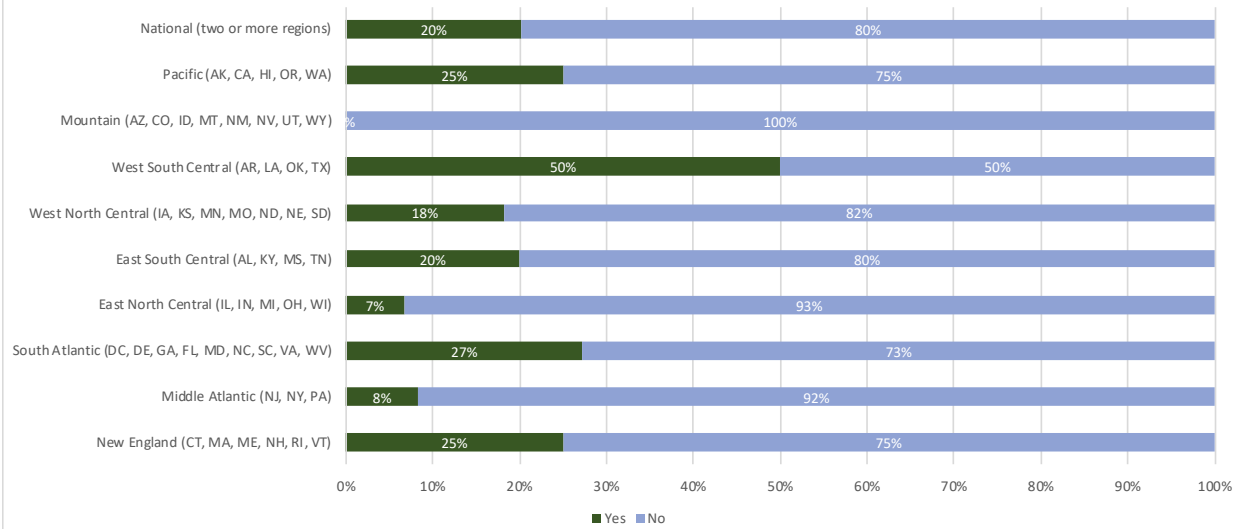
Q3c: Limitations on numbers of workers at a job site



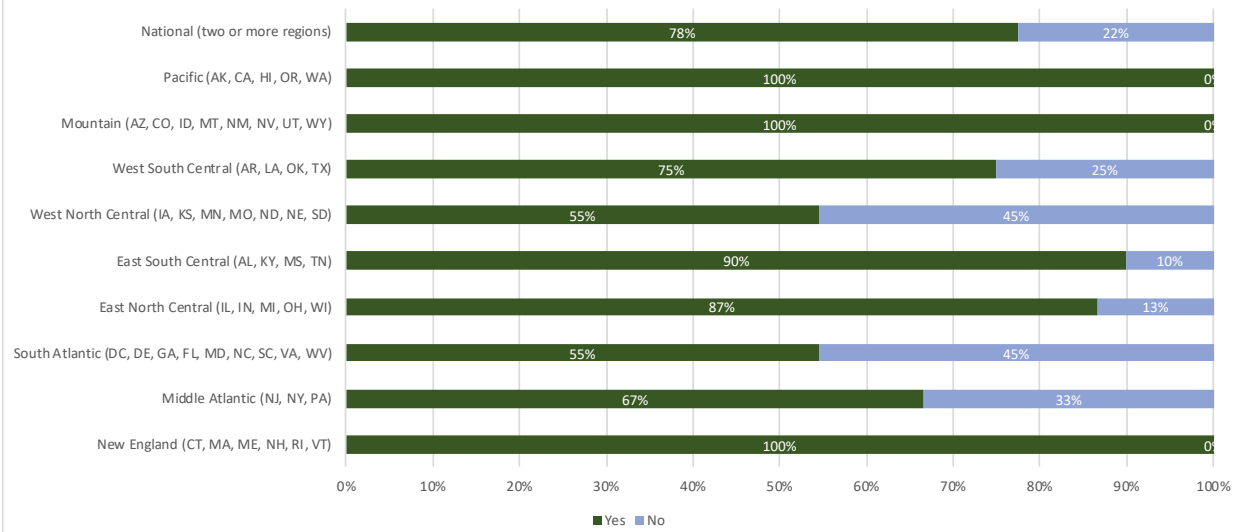
Q3d: Only allowing one trade at a time on job sites

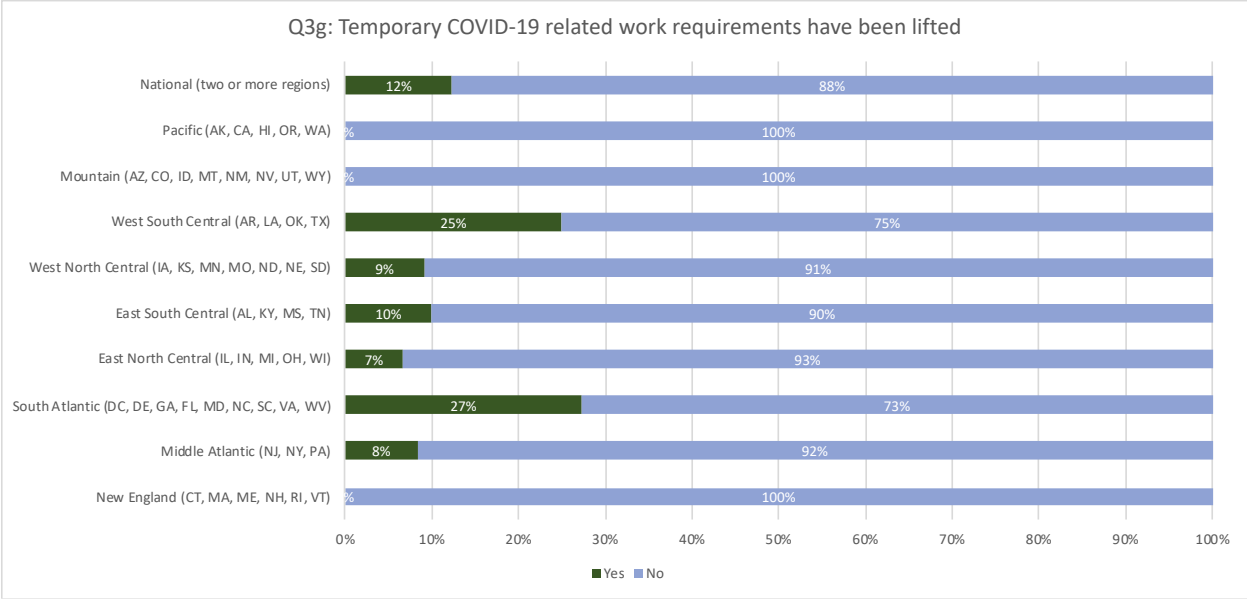


Q3e: Limitations on traveling to and from jobs



Q3f: Required job site safety plans for COVID-19



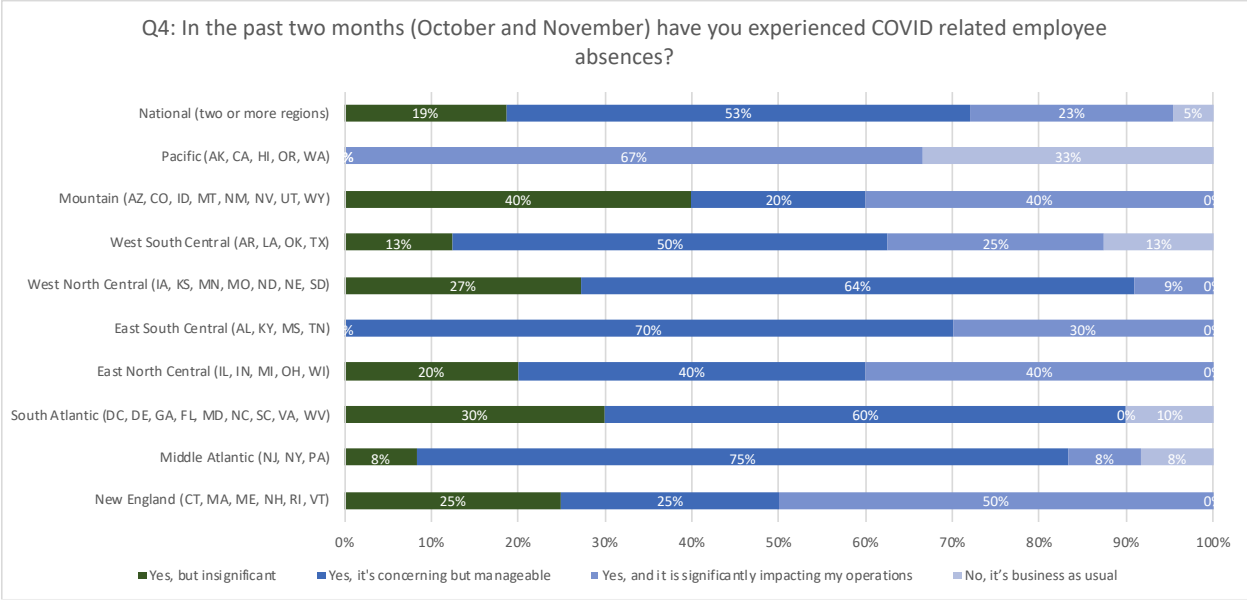


Comments:

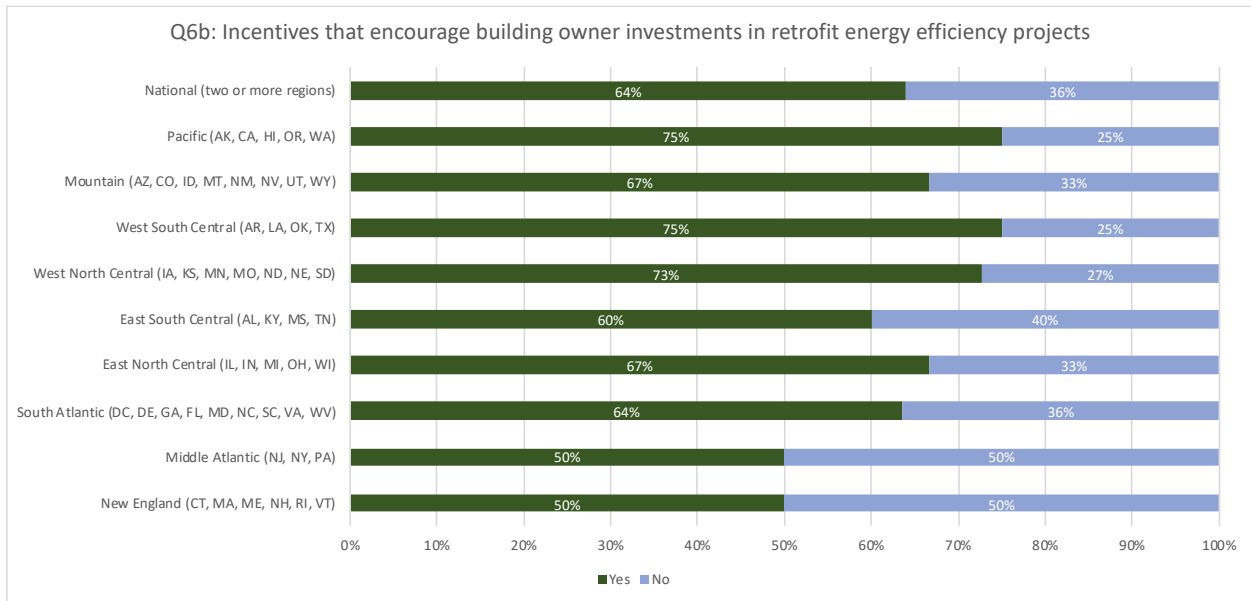
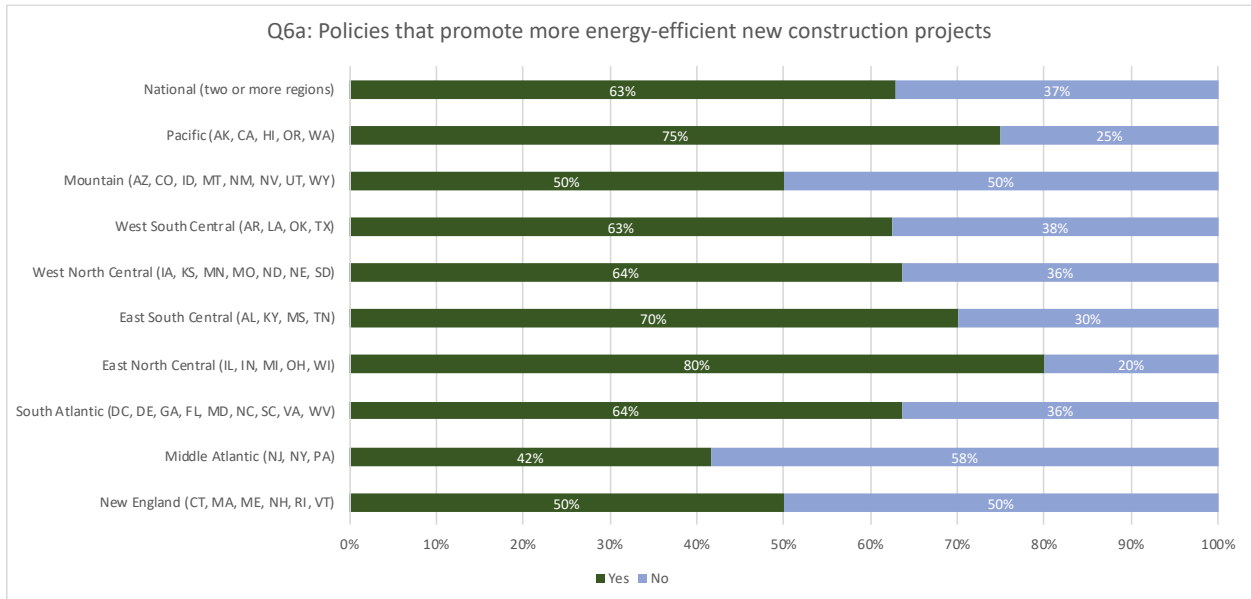


Comments:

“It's hard to get people to want to work. Many would rather stay home, and they have no problem telling us that.”

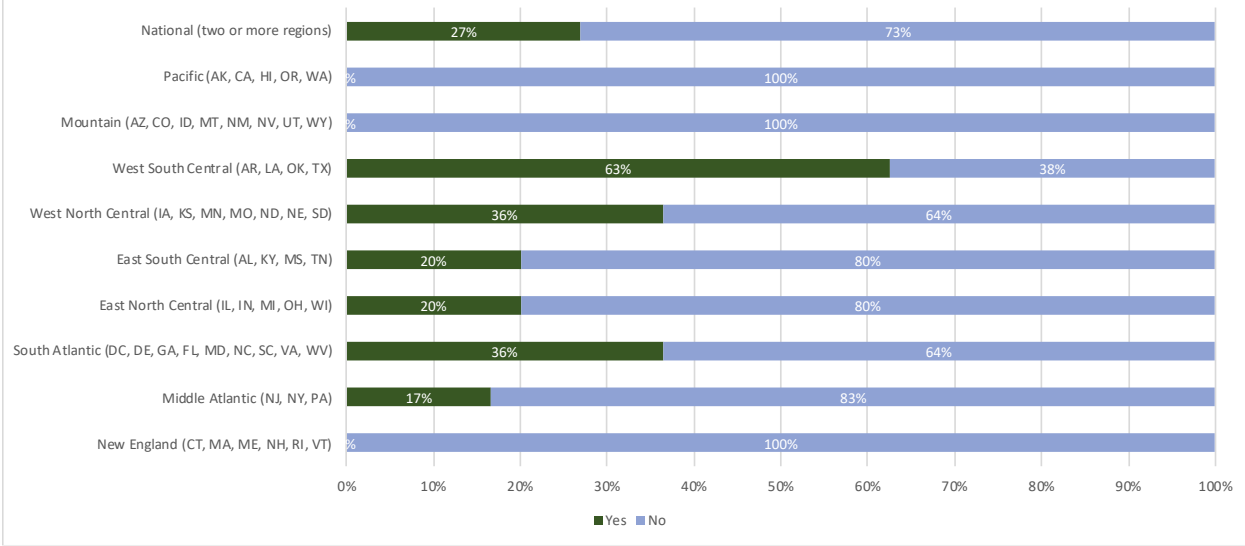
“We are too slow to hire. But workers are not really available anyway.”

Q6: What government policies would be most beneficial to your business? (Select all that apply)

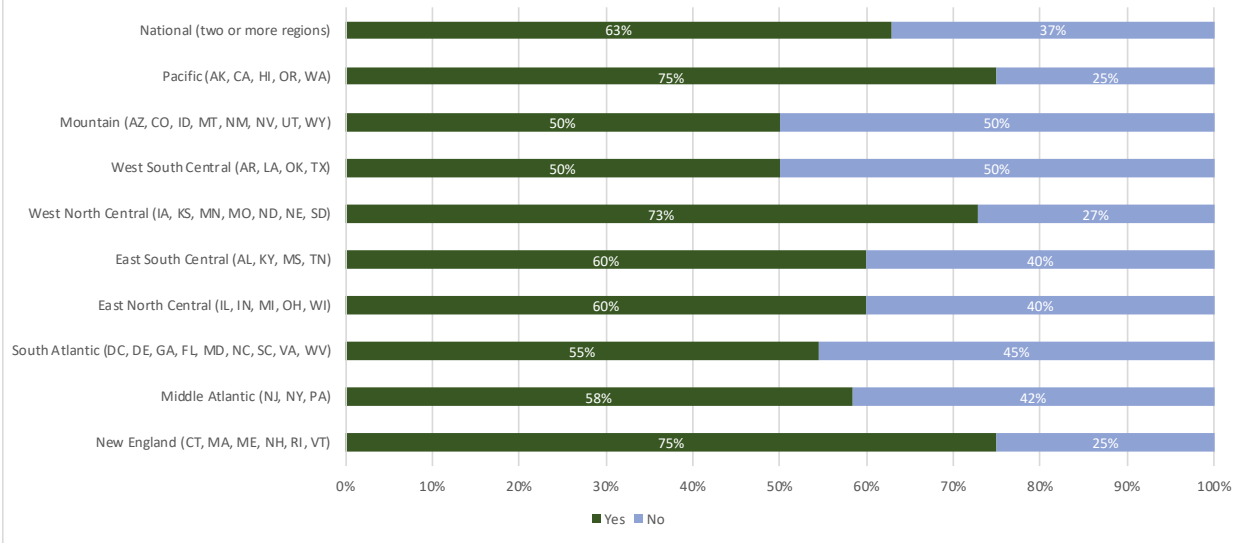




Q6c: Federal infrastructure investments that address climate change



Q6d: Incentives relating to commercial growth/retrofits

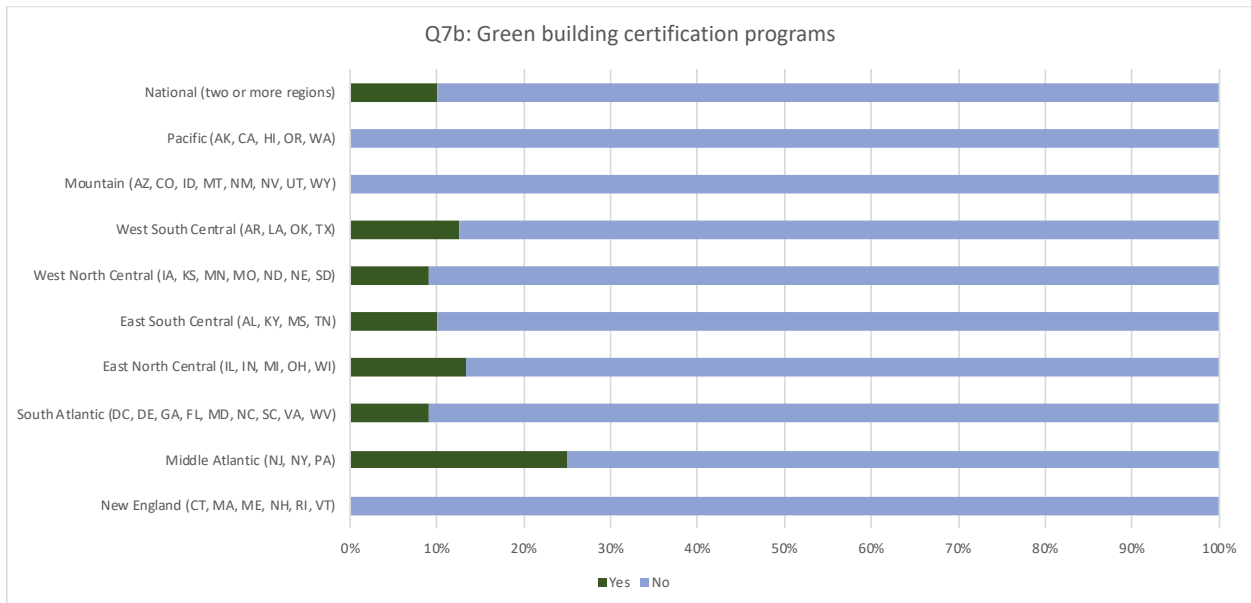
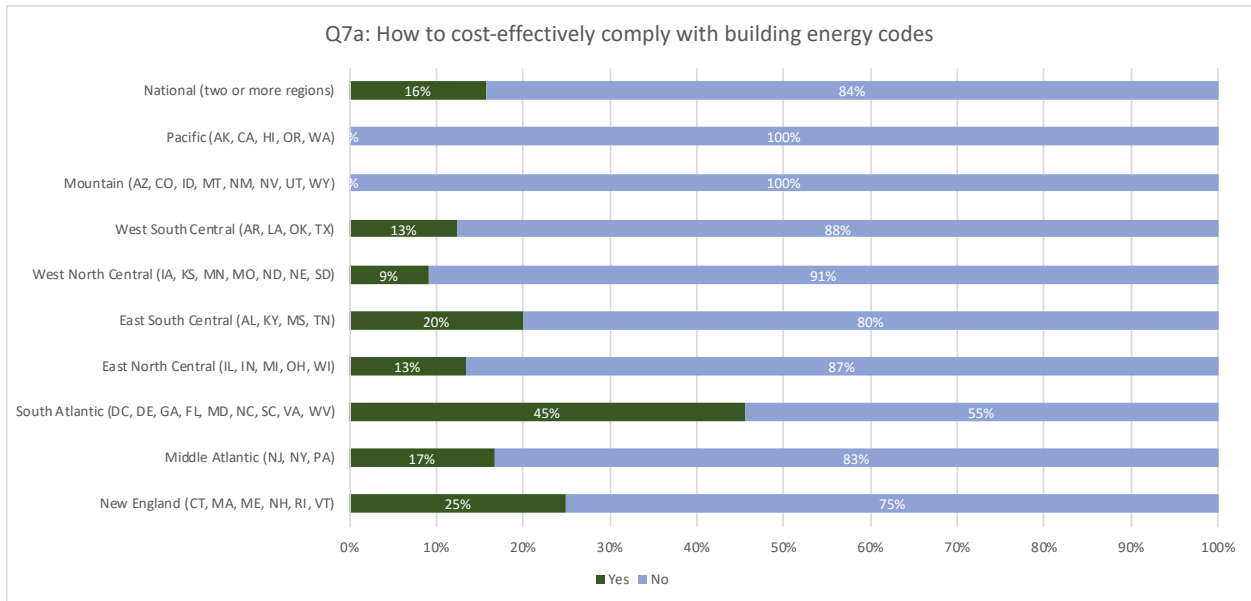
