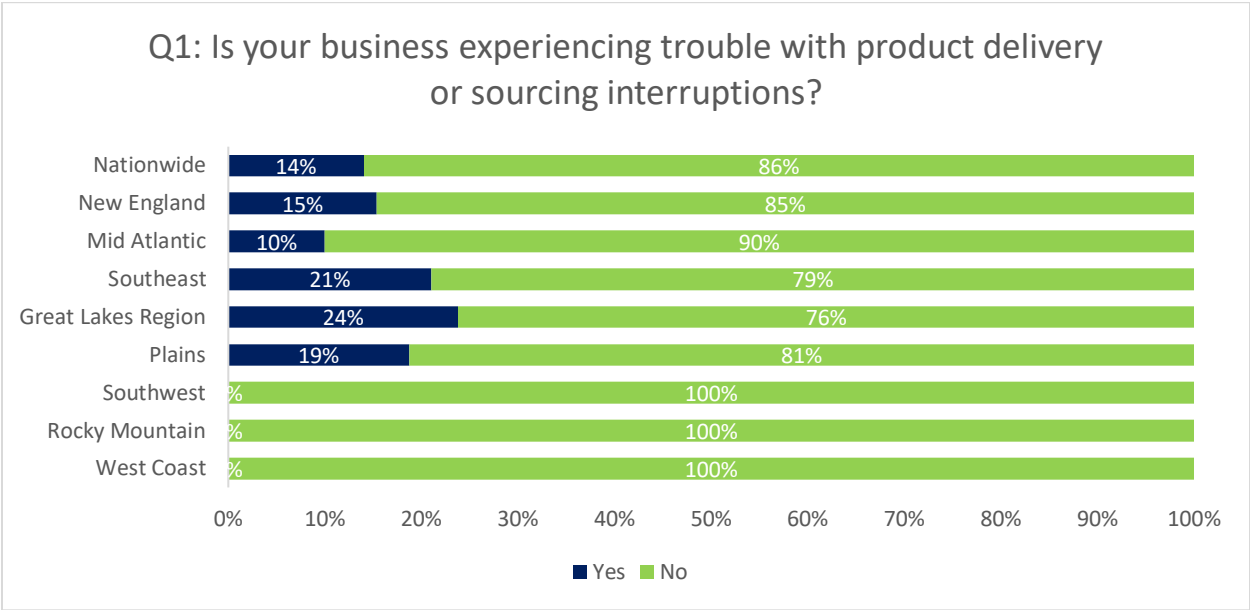


**COMMERCIAL, MECHANICAL, AND INDUSTRIAL INSULATION CONTRACTORS SURVEY 4.17.20**

“PPE, cleaning products, and some equipment. Insulation not a problem so far”

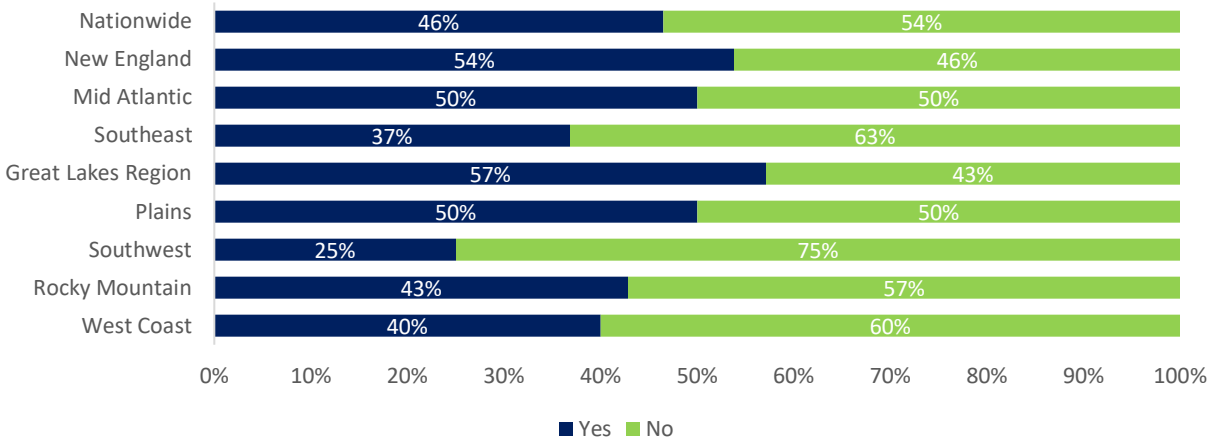
“Slight slow down”

“Some employees have had to stay home to watch kids”

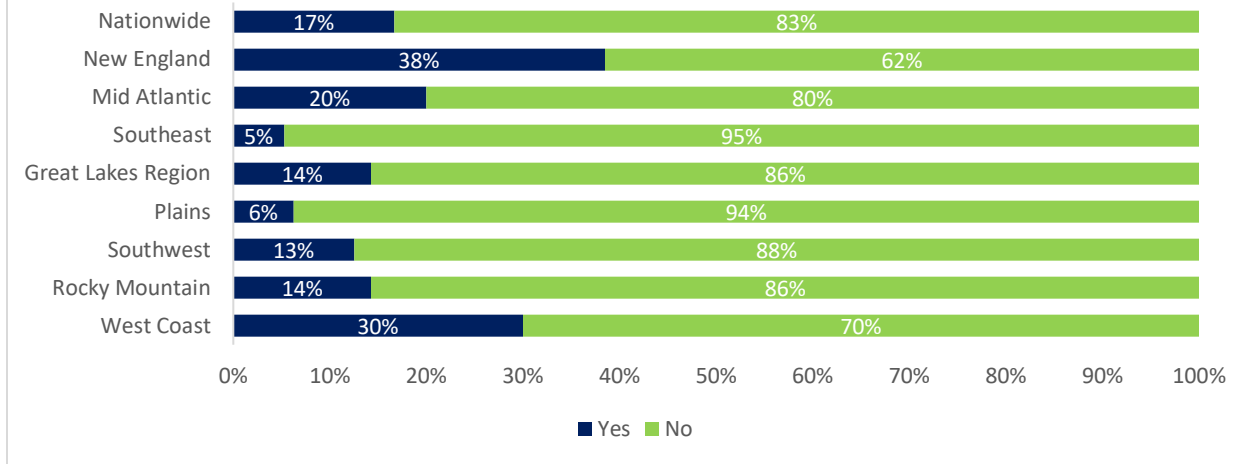
“1/27 self-quarantine and a higher than usual number of installers calling in sick day-to-day”

### Q3: Has any worker in your organization tested positive for coronavirus?

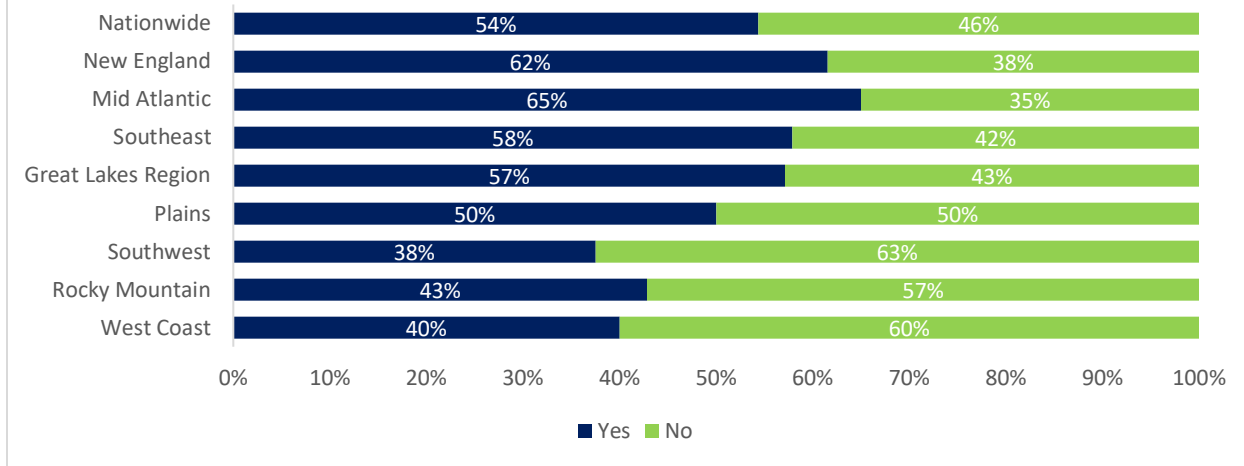


#### Selected Comments:

#### Selected Comments:

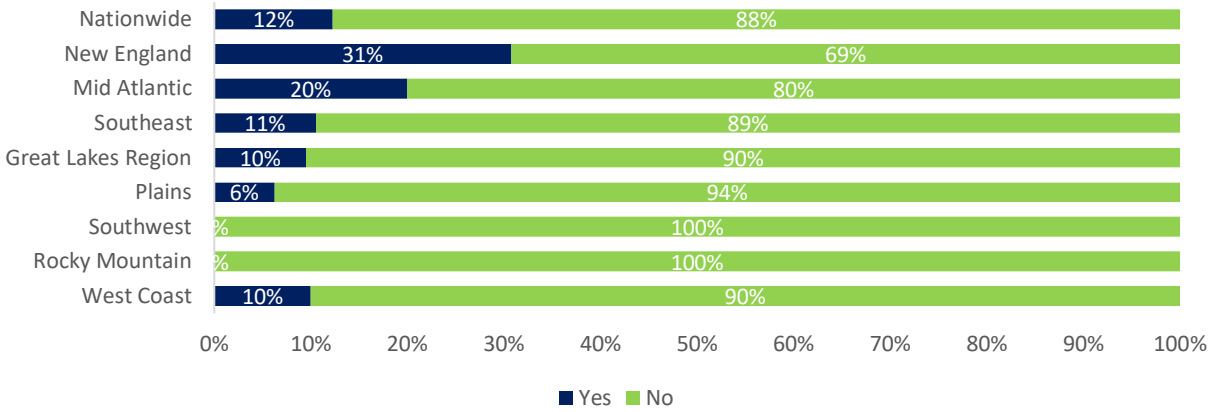
“Only on some jobs”

Q5: Have local jurisdictions (or other authorities) indicated that they will issue stop work orders that apply to your operations? If yes, what jurisdiction(s)?



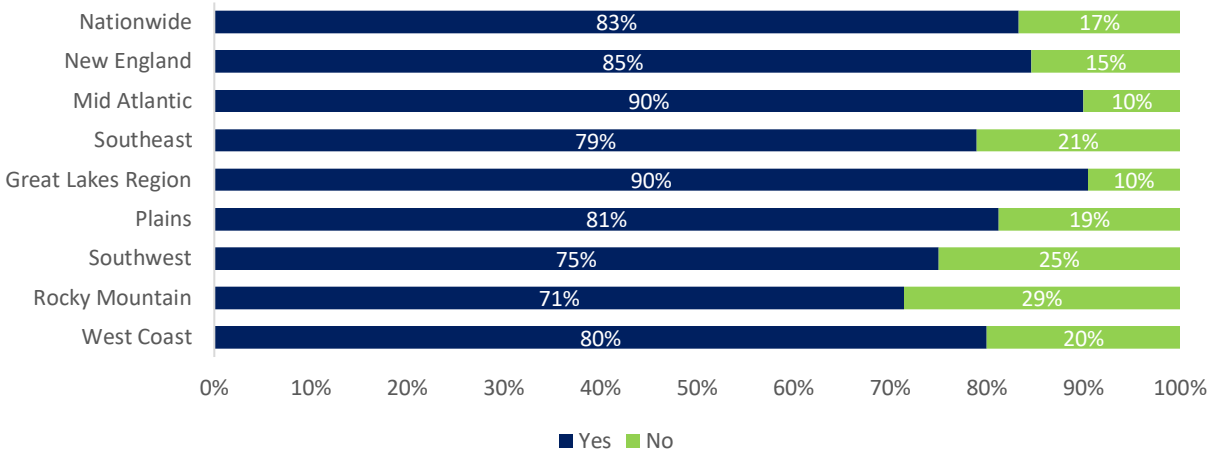

Q6: Are building owners/managers limiting access to sites and buildings as part of their coronavirus response plan?

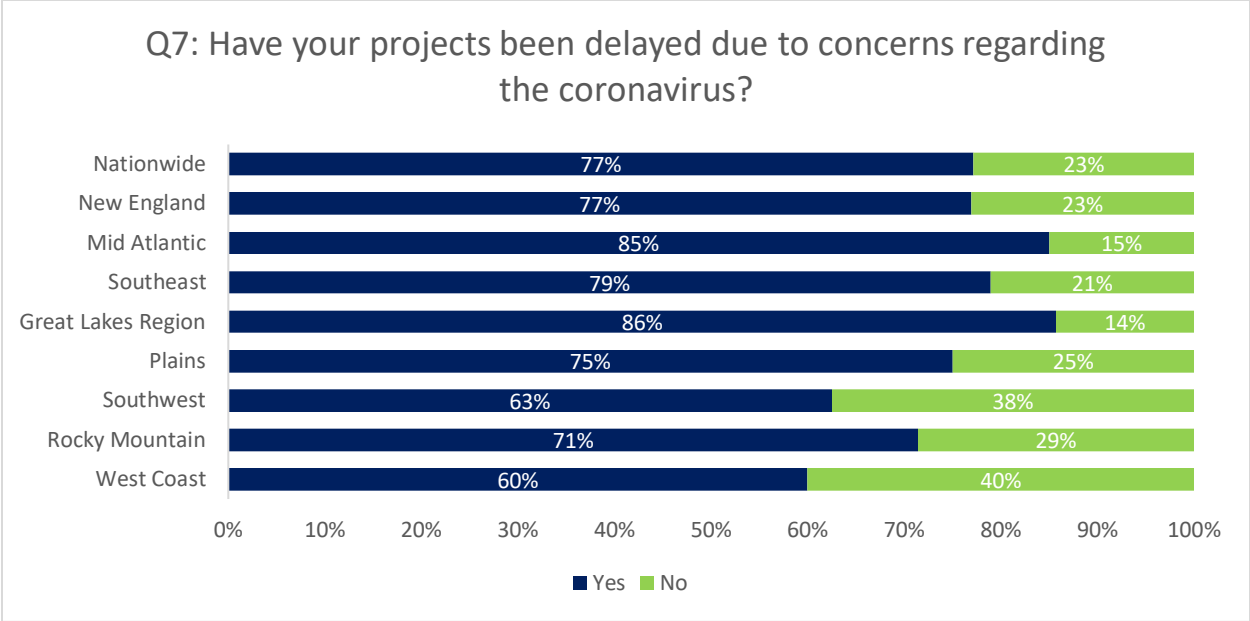


Selected Comments:

“Only a very limited number have closed down projects.”



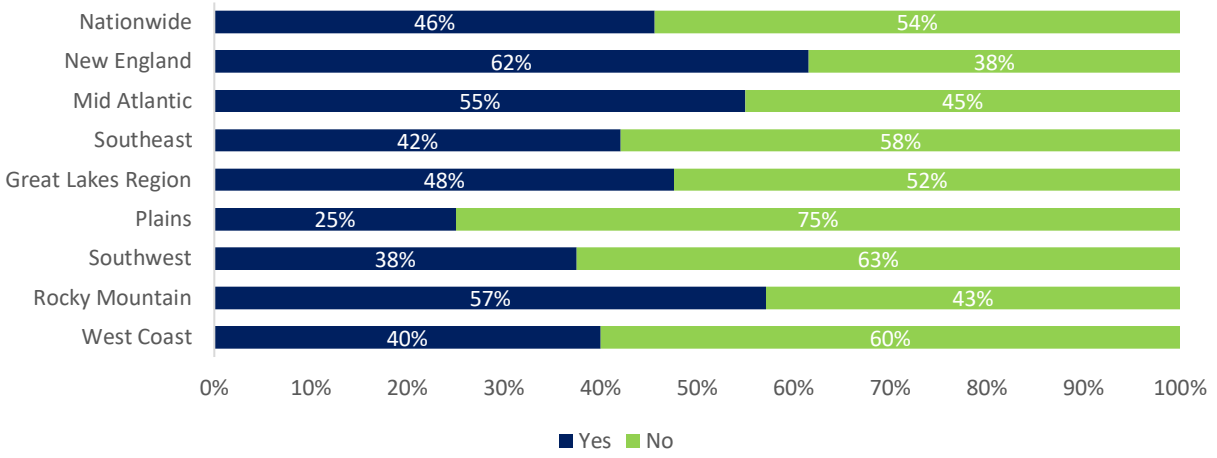

#### Selected Comments:

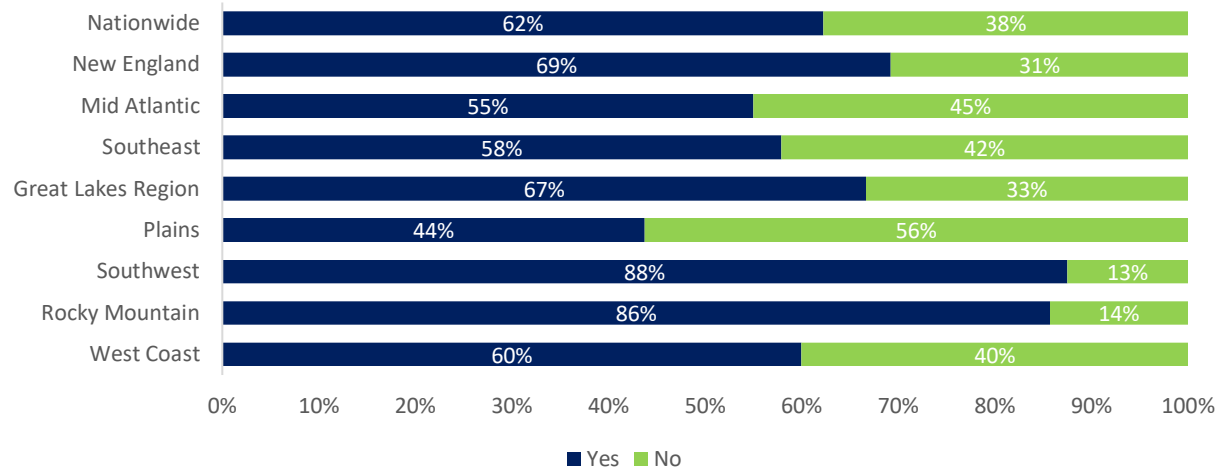
“Some are postponed until further notice”

Q9: Have you experienced a slowdown in normal bid activity due to the coronavirus?



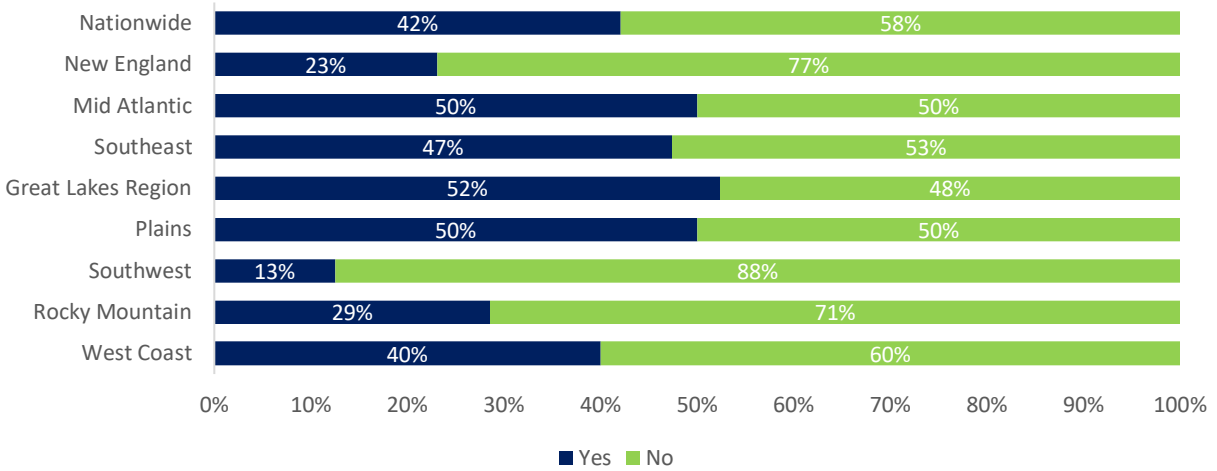
Selected Comments:

“In fact, the opposite as firms in the area take advantage of their office employees working from home to complete HVAC system upgrades”

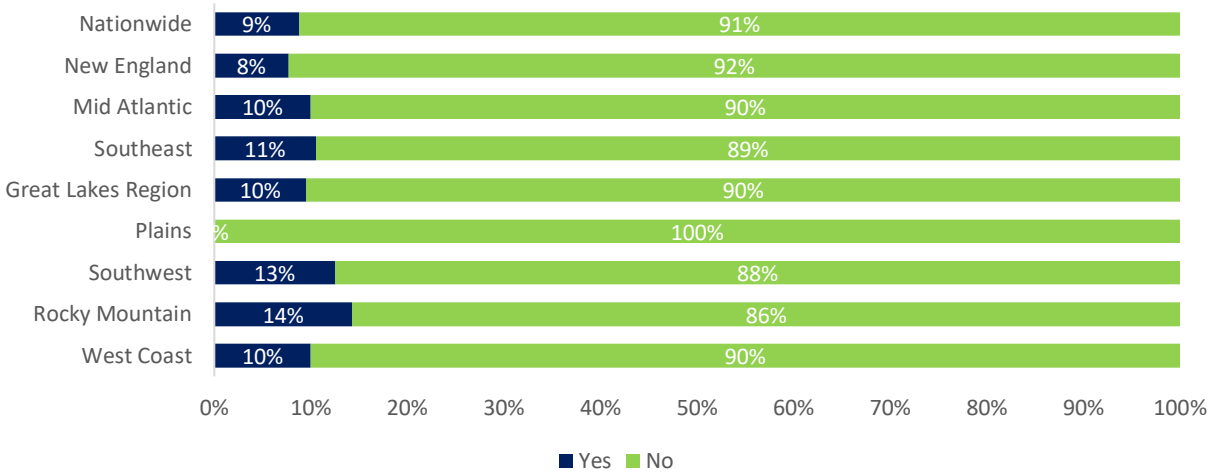
“Yes, but not significantly.”
